WHY RECYCLE?

Recycling benefits our community, our country, and the world by conserving natural resources, protecting the environment, and reducing the amount of waste that ends up in the landfill.

...And it is the law.

Recyclables that are not properly prepared or separated will be refused at the Town of La Valle collection site. Your cooperation is critical to the success of the site.

The Town of La Valle Recycling Center is for residential property owners only and is located on Thompson Road, La Valle.

Town of La Valle businesses are not allowed to use the recycling center by town ordinance.

Waste hauling and recycling hours?

WINTER HOURS: Saturday 8-Noon Sunday 1-4

Closed Holidays

If a holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, or if inclement weather, the recycling center will be open the next available Wednesday. 1:00 – 4:00.

*No construction or demolition materials. Commercial boat tarps will be refused.

WHAT COMPACTORS DO I USE? IF YOU ARE UNSURE: PLEASE ASK BEFORE TOSSING.

The Town of La Valle Waste Hauling and Recycling Center has clearly marked compactors for all of the items you bring to the site.

Recyclable Compactor:

Tin cans, aluminum cans; plastics. Please rinse and remove caps from bottles and jars. Plastic bags can go into the recyclable compactor, or consider taking them back to the stores in their bag receptacle.

*****Aluminum cans can be placed in the recyclable compactor. Consider donating these to the Fireworks funds by taking them to the trailer that is located next to the Fire Department building. They would appreciate your donation. Please make sure you only have aluminum cans in the bag.**

Cardboard Compactor:

Newspaper, magazines, flattened cardboard; Please do not place in bags, bundled or tie together. These items can be in a box. These items DO NOT go into the recyclable compactor.

Remember: No dog or cat food bags, No feed or fertilizer bags. No tissue paper or paper towels. These go into the Trash Compactor.

Trash Compactor:

House hold trash; These items do not get recycled but are transported to the land fill. Please do not co-mingle with newspaper, magazines, or cardboard.

Questions on other items.....

Paint - No liquids accepted. Cans must be empty and dry. Tip: Take the lid off the paint can and let it air dry.

At this time the Town of La Valle accepts ALL EMPTIED household containers, remove caps. Accepted codes: PETE, HDPE, V, LDPE, PP, PS.
